

Whilst at college recently our territorial commander gave us a gift of a vanity mirror and asked us the question who and what do we see when we look into it. For some, spending time looking into a mirror can be a joyous thing. Time can be spent creating the perfect reflection of the image that we want people to see of us. This at first can sound like a vain activity, but for some this act of 'making up' can be a real boost to their self-esteem.

There are other however, who try at all costs to avoid catching even the slightest glimpse of them selves in the mirror for fear of what could be looking back at them.

What we must remember when we think about our image is that we have a God that doesn't judge us by how we look in the mirror, instead he loves us simply for who we are.

God Sees Our Inner Being, Not Outward Appearance, and there are lots of examples of this that can be found in scripture and 1 Samuel 16:7 is a great reminder of this.

But God told Samuel, "Looks aren't everything. Don't be impressed with his looks and stature. I've already eliminated him. God judges persons differently than humans do. Men and women look at the face; God looks into the heart."

This passage highlights that God is not concerned with outward appearances or worldly metrics of success. He cares most about the heart and character. While humans judge by what they can see on the outside, God sees who we truly are on the inside

He values inner qualities like integrity, humility, and love and this is an amazing comfort for those who feel inadequate by worldly standards.

God loves us for who we are, not how we look or what we achieve. So friends let us always remember that no matter how we feel about the mirrors in your life, you are perfect just the way your are, because that is the way that God made you.

STREET FOODBANK NEWS

The foodbank continues to be busy, and we are always thankful for donations of non perishable food that come through our door.

The following items are those with the lowest stock:

⇒ Tinned Meat ⇒ Tea Bags (packs of 80)

We work with agencies to identify those in need of help, but we do sometimes take self referrals if necessary.

Food parcels that we provide contain non perishable food, fresh or frozen food from FareShare where possible, and Aldi vouchers. All of which provides a good offering of food to those who need it. We take food parcel requests up to 1.00pm each day and then aim to deliver out to clients that afternoon.
