## **Bristol Churches Shelter**

Bristol Churches Shelter (BCS) is a partnership of churches in Bristol and the surrounding area, governed by inHope, which provides food, accommodation, and support for homeless people to move on to stable housing. The Bristol based shelter is open for 5-6 months over the winter period each year, currently hiring a Guest house with 9 bedrooms. The project is run by three staff members and over 100 volunteers from around 20 churches in Bristol. Volunteers play a vital role in the running of the shelter, there are many ways people can get involved; baking, making meals, volunteering for shifts at the shelter (12-2pm or 6.30-10pm). Over the 7 years of running, 100's of volunteers have connected with this project and have helped many homeless people - last year (2023-24) BCS were able to help 26 people and 23 were able to move on to secure housing afterwards and start to move on with their lives and out of the difficult situations they were in.
