### PRAYER MATTERS

Bible verses for Summer are featured this week.

**Monday 1 July** – Read Isaiah 28 v 4. *Summer quotation by Wilma Rudolph:* 'When the sun is shining I can do anything; no mountain is too high, no trouble is too difficult to overcome'. Pray prayers of thanksgiving today for all the good things the Lord has provided. (Song 701 'For they that wait upon the Lord')

**Tuesday 2 July** – Read James 1 v 17. Summer quotation by Henry James: 'Summer afternoon - summer afternoon; to me those have always been the two most beautiful words in the English language'. How will you spend your afternoon? Make someone happy today by giving them a call. Pray for people you know who live alone. (Song 711 'In heavenly love abiding')

**Wednesday 3 July** – Read Proverbs 10 v 15. Summer quotation by Bryan Proctor: 'Oh, the summer night has a smile of light and she sits on a sapphire throne'. Summer evenings can be so enjoyable. Listening to a musical group performing in some outdoor situation. Walking along the seafront or driving through the Dorset countryside. Pray evening prayers of thanksgiving for the privilege of life itself. (Song 696 'At even, ere the sun was set')

**Thursday 4 July** – Read Psalm 74 v 17. *Summer quotation by Wallace Stevens: 'The summer night is like a perfection of thought'*. Summer nights can be enjoyable, but for some people very lonely as they think of former days. Think of and pray for such people. (Song 792 'Thank you for these quiet minutes')

**Friday 5 July** – Read Luke 21 v 29-36. *Summer quotation from a Swedish Proverb: 'A life without love is like a year without summer'*. Think of someone you know who would benefit from a loving arm around them. Pray for them or write a note of friendship and assurance. (Song 994 'Yield not to temptation')

**Saturday 6 July** – Read Mark13 v 28. *Summer quotation by Audrey Hepburn: 'To plant a garden is to believe in tomorrow'*. It is a real pleasure to plant a garden. In my long years I have planted many gardens and enjoyed the fruits of my labours. Fresh vegetables, beautiful flowers, fruit trees producing tasty and juicy fruit. If possible why not say your prayers in the garden today. (Song 14 'For the beauty of the earth')

**Sunday 7 July** – Read Genesis 8 v 22. *Summer Quotation by an unknown author: 'Friends, sun, sand and sea, that sounds like summer to me'. Summer Quotation by Helen Keller: 'Keep your face to the sunshine and you will never see the shadows'.* We are privileged to experience all four in Bournemouth ~ Sun ~ Sand ~ Sea ~ Friends. Pray for the holidaymakers today. Pray for your close friends, maybe one special friend who would value your individual prayers today. (Song 27 'Guide my, O thou great Jehovah')
