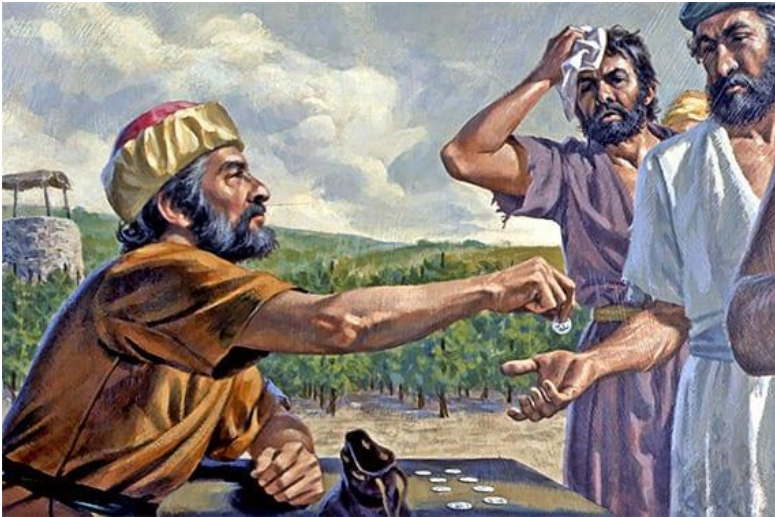

Lets join with our Jewish brothers and sisters for Tashlich. It is a tradition in Judaism that during the penitential season they “cast their

sins into the sea". They take pebbles, and silently naming each one with a sin that they ask God to forgive, they throw them one by one into the water.

But modern Jews acknowledge, as of course do most sane people, that in our times we humans are casting our sins into the sea all the time, with plastics, sewage and all the other forms of pollution. Our response is Reverse Tashlich. We symbolically remove our sins from the sea, by cleaning the beach.
