PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 21 October – Autumn is a season of beauty. Let us look at verses in Scripture about beauty and God's beautiful creations. Read 1 Peter 3 v

3-4: 'Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as elaborate hairstyles and the wearing of gold jewellery or fine clothes. rather it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight'. Consider in prayer ways that your conversation reveals the beauty of Jesus. (Song 717 'Let the beauty of Jesus be seen in me')

Tuesday 22 October – Read Ephesians 2 v 10: 'For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do'. What are we going to do for the Lord today? Pray for people who spend their days revealing spiritual beauty and love through their active service. (Song 261 'Lord, the light of your love is shining')

Wednesday 23 October – Read Isaiah 40 v 8: 'The grass withers, the flower fades but the word of our God will stand forever'. How inspiring to sit quietly and read the Word of God. Beautiful stories of truth which inspire and challenge us. Use Scripture verses in your prayertime today. (Song 802 'Break thou the Bread of Life')

Thursday 24 October – Read Psalm 139 v 14: 'I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Your works are wonderful, I know that full well'. Let us give thanks for who we are. The amazing things we are able to do because of how we are made and the gifts imparted to us by the Lord. Thank the Lord for your mind, your hands, your eyes, your feet. your heart. (Song 42 'Let us with a gladsome mind. Praise the Lord for He is kind')

Friday 25 October – Read 1 Samuel 16 v 7: 'But the Lord said to Samuel, 'Do not consider his appearance or height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart'. (Song 709 'I want to walk with Jesus')

Saturday 26 October – Read Ecclesiastes 3 v 11: 'He has made everything beautiful in His time'. Consider some of the beautiful things you will see today. To see the beautiful trees that are present in most areas of Bournemouth. A child's face which can make you smile, no matter how you feel. The moment after the rain stops ... everything looks fresh. So many beautiful things to see in God's world. Pray and thank God for this new day. (Song 3 'All things bright and beautiful')

Sunday 27 October – Read Romans 8 v 6: 'The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the spirit is life and peace'. Worshipping God is a beautiful experience. Worshipping God means acknowledging and celebrating His power and perfection, in gratitude. Worship includes understanding and care of God's Holiness. We remember how great He is and behave reverently in His presence. Pray and sing song 52. 'O worship the King, all glorious above; O gratefully sing his power and his love'.
