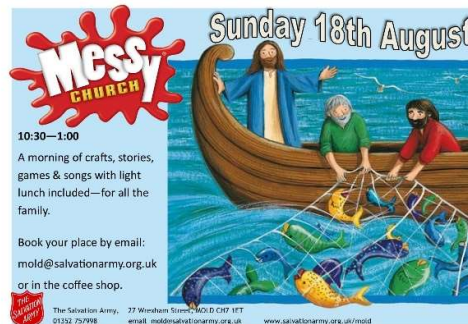
There was:
