### **M4 Road Closure**

You may have heard that next weekend the M4 will be closed in both directions between junctions 18 and 19. This will probably cause significant disruption on many of the roads we use to get to our building – please give yourself extra time to arrive for the morning meeting and Messy church next weekend.

The M4 will be closed in both directions between junctions 18 and 19 from 7pm Friday 18 October to 6am Monday 21 October. This closure is part of our work on the A432 Badminton Road Bridge.

During the closure, we'll be digging trenches under the motorway. The trenches will allow utilities to be diverted that are currently within the bridge. Where possible, noisy work will be completed in the day so that overnight noise is kept to a minimum. The bridge is then due to be demolished next year.

A local diversion route will be in place using the A46, A420, A4174 and M32, which is expected to be very busy. Please follow diversion signs and not satnays.

This is one of the busiest sections of motorway in the south west. The closure is likely to cause substantial disruption. If you are planning to travel, allow yourself plenty of extra time to complete your journey.

We carefully plan our schemes to limit any inconvenience. However, sometimes it's not possible to carry out the work without a closure.

If we are unable to complete our work as planned, the M4 junction 18 to 19 will be closed again from 7pm Friday 25 October to 6am Monday 28 October. Keep an eye on our social media channels for more information.
