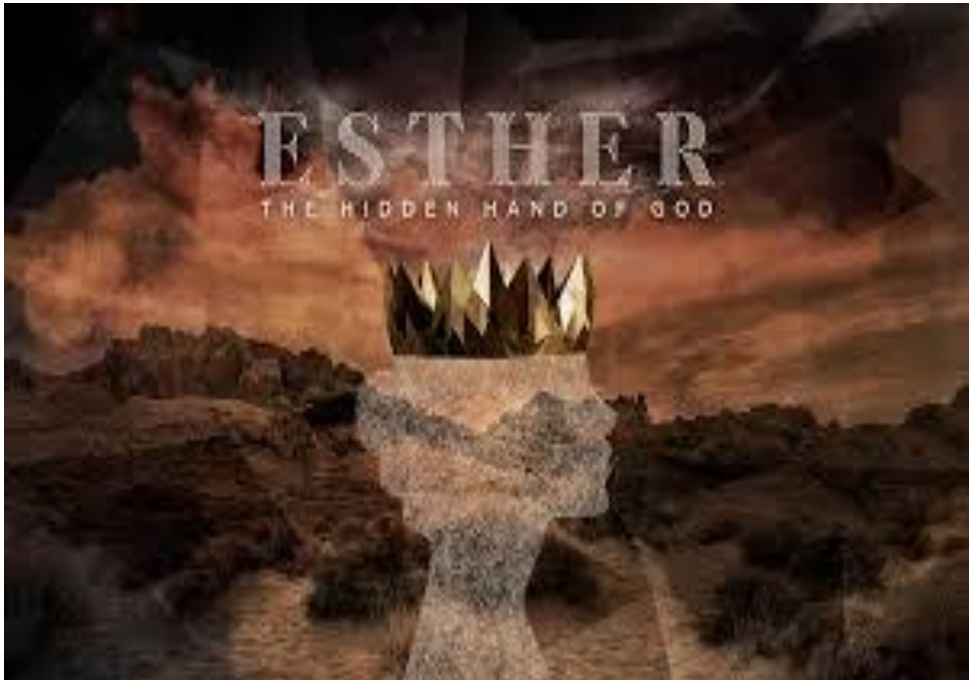

 Please continue to pray for all those who have been bereaved recently.

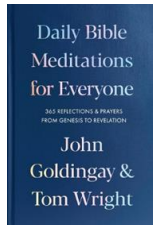
 Please pray for those who are unable to join us for worship and in particular for our shut-ins and those in Nursing/Care Homes
