

Prayer thoughts from 'Hazelnuts' by Julian of Norwich.

Monday 25 November – 'The Spirit is our clothing, for in love, the Divine One wraps us up, holds us tight, and encloses us with tenderness'. Loving Lord, we hold the child within our human fragility throughout life and give thanks for the consolation of this ministry from nearly seven hundred years ago. Amen.

Tuesday 26 November – 'The Divine Essence fits all things together perfectly and sweetly. It is the substance of reality, the essence of all that is'. Loving Lord, we appear to be surrounded with unreality wherever we look and feel aggrieved by false information. We praise you for the knowledge that You are Reality and in you we can put our trust. Amen.

Wednesday 27 November – 'God loved us before we were made, and when we were made we loved God'. Loving Lord, thank you for providing us with the security of those who look to a parent joyfully and confidently. Amen.
