PRAYER MATTERS

Hope you've had a good week. In my Songster devotions last year, I spoke about the ups and downs of life and how God has promised to be with us in every situation that comes our way. I hope you find comfort in a few thoughts that I read some time ago, and used that night, to illustrate God's continual presence.

Bible verse for the week: 'Don't worry about anything whatever, tell God every detail of your needs in earnest and thankful prayer, and the peace of God which transcends human understanding, will keep constant guard over your hearts and minds' (Philippians 4:6-7)

Monday 20 January – Every Day God thinks of you. 'Praise be to the Lord, to God our Saviour, who daily bears our burdens' (Psalm 68:19). *Pray: 'Father, I know you are thinking of me now, at this very moment. What a blessing to have you near, Thank you'*.

Tuesday 21 January – Every Hour God looks after you. 'But the Master never lets us down, He'll stick by you and protect you from evil' (1 Thessalonians 3:3). Pray: 'Father, thank you for looking after me, looking out for me, and protecting me. That's such a comforting feeling. Thank you'.

Wednesday 22 January – Every Minute God cares for you. 'You can throw the whole weight of your anxieties on Him, for you are His personal concern (1 Peter 5:7). **Pray:** 'Father, I am humbled that you care for me personally every minute of every day. I place my life in Your hands, such caring hands. Thank you.'

Thursday 23 January – Because every second He loves you. 'I have loved you with everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness' (Jeremiah 31:3). Pray: 'Father you are the one constant in my life, You are the same yesterday, today and tomorrow and every second you love me. Thank you'.

Friday 24 January – There is so much to think about in those four short statements. This is God's grace in action, and all we need to do is trust and believe. In 'Only Fools and Horses' Rodney was going through a difficult patch and Del Boy simply said, 'Never stop believing eh son!'. *Pray: 'Father, grant me the faith to never stop believing for every second of every day I can depend on You, because you love me'*.

Saturday 25 January – My prayer for you today: 'May His presence go before you, and behind you, and beside you, and around you, and within you. He is with you; He is with you'. **Never stop believing!**

Sunday 26 January – Just a final word this week from Ephesians 3:20-21. (JB Phillips translation): 'Now to Him who by His power within us, is able to do far more than we ever dare to ask or imagine – to Him be glory in the Church through Jesus Christ for ever and ever, Amen!'

Wherever you may be today, take time to pause and rest in God's presence.
