May we all feel the welcome of God and each other.

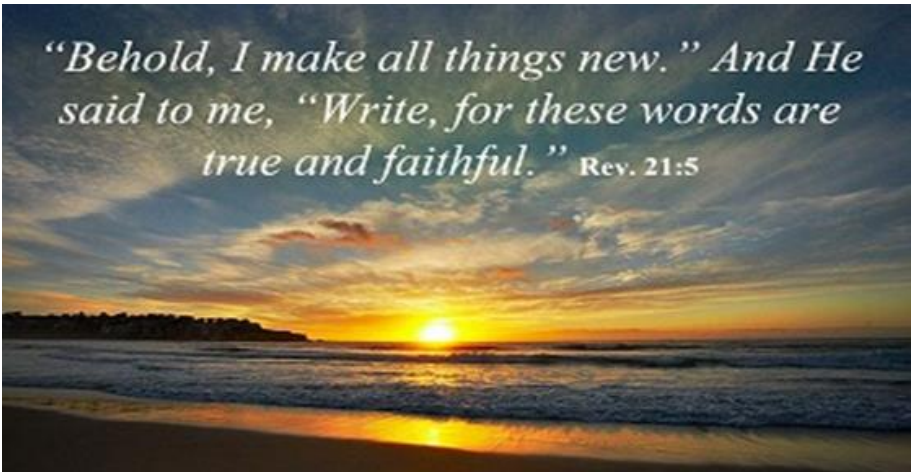
We meet at The Salvation Army Hall Sunday 10.30 am.
